Arrive early as the Registration table

will pack up and move to Room 153 at 10:00am.

The program will begin promptly at 10:00am in PG 153

If Driving, Purchase Permit On-line BEFORE event to SAVE \$4.00, Permit Instructions

Purchase your parking permit for **\$6.00** ahead of time.

Print out your ticket and follow driving directions.

Place your ticket on your dash to avoid any parking citations on Thursday, July 13th

Driving and Parking Directions *Peterson Gym is on 55th and Montezuma*

FROM I-8 EAST:

Take I-8 West to College Ave

Exit College Ave and go left

Keep left to College Ave, heading South (up) College Ave

Right on Montezuma Rd

Right on 55th St

Parking Structure 7 is on your immediate left

If you did not Pre-Purchase your \$6.00 ticket on line, pull up to the yellow ticket booth and purchase a parking ticket. An All-day permit is \$10.00. This is required to avoid getting a citation from SDSU Police.

FROM I-8 WEST:

Take I-8 East to Exit 7B on to Fairmount Ave, toward Mission Gorge Rd

Keep left on Fairmount Ave toward Mission Gorge Rd

Keep right on Fairmount Ave toward Mission Gorge Rd

Right on Fairmount Ave South

Keep right to Montezuma Rd

Left on 55th St

Parking Structure 7 is on your immediate left

If you did not Pre-Purchase your \$6.00 ticket on line, pull up to the yellow ticket booth and purchase a parking ticket. An All-day permit is \$10.00. This is required to avoid getting a citation from SDSU Police.

The Transfer Student Success Event is free, lunch & drinks are provided. All students who complete the evaluation at the end of the day will also receive a free academic planner valued at \$25.00. All students are responsible for any parking citations issued as a result of attending our event. Walking Directions to Peterson Gym from Parking Structure 7

Exit the parking structure from where you drove in, turn left, and continue walking straight down the sidewalk until you pass the Parma Payne Goodall (PPG) Alumni Center and Fowler's Athletic Center on your left.

Once you pass the outdoor seating area for BCB Coffee Cart, you will see the Registration Table. Check in at the Transfer Student Outreach Alliance table.

NOTE: No students are not allowed to enter Room 153 until 9:50 am.
Please do not disturb, as a class is in session.

Trolley and Walking Directions to Peterson Gym

Attached is a map if you prefer to take the Trolley into campus.

From the SDSU trolley station, once you exit the station (use the elevators to go to ground level), make a left and walk straight.

If you exit using the escalators, you will need to make a left turn and go up the stairs onto ground level, then make a right and go straight.

Continue going straight, follow the bike path, go down the stairs or the slight hill, and continue onwards. You will need to pass our Viejas Arena, which should be on your right.

Once you get to a stop light, make a right and walk for a block until you get to the crosswalk. Cross the crosswalk and continue heading until you see the registration table.

NOTE: No students are not allowed to enter Room 153 until 9:50 am.
Please do not disturb, as a class is in session.
